This is a long term project and should be carefully planned out in order to avoid automatic payments being missed and outstanding checks being accounted for. In addition, we have several busy administrative months approaching. Between Bylaw reviews, Policy updates, and Budget meetings we need to make sure that we work at a measured progressive pace.

I processed the literature order online from our Literature Chair Erin B. in the amount of \$188.03 on 6/16/17. I was not yet forwarded the receipts for this order. Erin B. was attempting to work out a solution to getting the H&I literature order sent directly to a facility, and was hoping to have the order ready to process by this month’s area, unfortunately it seems that this was not able to happen.

Our deposit from June’s ASC was \$680.53. The income breakdown is on the second to last page and will be inserted into the minutes for this ASC.

The bank ad-hoc subcommittee did not get a chance to get together this month, due in part to me not reaching out to the members and trying to get something together. I will attempt to do so early this month.

Last month I did not receive a money order from Antoinette B, and she is paid up through half of April. She owes half of April, May, June, and this month’s amount (\$140.00 total) to stay current.

Our expected balance as of the start of today’s ASC is \$3,027.71. Minus the quarterly estimated budgeted amounts for all subcommittees and prudent reserve (\$1,167.25 x2) leaves us \$693.21 **above** prudent reserve.

XI. Regional Committee Member I & II Report: Richard M.

During open sharing at the June RSC

Topic of apathy of NA members towards service and service reports was brought up. Ideas on how to get people engaged were presented. Get listeners physically involved with the presentation. Placement on the agenda can be helpful.

- a. RD brought up issue of scheduling CAR workshops for 2018. Looking for some locations where the CAR has not been presented lately. Looking for contacts from Outer Limits, New River, Gateway to Freedom, Tri-Cities.
- b. Issues with the Zoom conference for the May subcommittee meetings. PR chair accidentally was late in trying to get the web conference on line plus the physical location had poor Wi-Fi which added to the difficulty of getting the meeting on air. If the Region is going to promote the use of technology to facilitate meeting attendance and participation then the trusted servants must do the due diligence to ensure that the technology is functional.
- c. RD was asked by Plain States AZF to do an orientation for their Step Working guides.
- d. Chair came up with an action item related to coordinating communication between H&I and PR chairs.

The RD team has been very involved in the planning our future for the WSC, I reported on this in my last report in April but in short they are trying to come up with a new way of conducting business at the wsc, the changes will make it possible to effectively communicate the large amount of information that is carried in the CAR report. The RD team also wants to know our areas feelings on Zonal Representation. So let me give a short explanation, at this time zones are information exchanging between regions, there are 9 zones in the world consisting of seated and non seated regions. Zonal representation would greatly reduce the number of people at the wsc, greatly reduce cost of the wsc, but on the flip side of that if we have a zone with 18 regions and 10 regions vote yes and 8 vote no, that zone is now carrying a yes vote for a small majority. Our RD team is completely willing to do a workshop specifically for giving us all the information, I would like to suggest and request the area to ask for a workshop, I would like to have a short discussion in open sharing to get the group conscience.
